


ORDINANCE NO. 9225-X O-24

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 9104-X, THE 2017-2018 BUDGET ORDINANCE PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$1,675,000 FOR THE EXPANSION OF THE CHARLOTTE B-CYCLE BIKE-SHARING PROGRAM

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Charlotte;

- Section 1. That the sum of \$1,000,000 hereby estimated to be available from the North Carolina Department of Transportation - Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Grant
- Section 2. That the sum of \$675,000 hereby estimated to be available from the North Carolina Department of Transportation - Transportation Alternative Program
- Section 3. That the sum of \$1,675,000 is hereby appropriated in the General Capital Investment Fund (4001) into the project Bike Share - 4292000428
GL: 4001-42-42-4250-429200-000000-000-530500-
- Section 4. That the existence of this project may extend beyond the end of the fiscal year. Therefore, this ordinance will remain in effect for the duration of the project and funds are to be carried forward to subsequent fiscal years until all funds are expended or the project is officially closed.
- Section 5. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
- Section 6. This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.

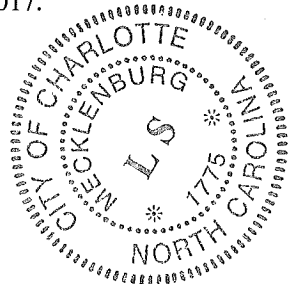




BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Charlotte;

- Section 1. That the sum of \$91,000 hereby estimated to be available from the following private developer sources:
TDCA Resource Square, LLC (\$40,000)
NR Stonewall Property Owner, LLC (\$51,000)
- Section 2. That the sum of \$91,000 is hereby appropriated in the General Capital Investment Fund (4001) into the following projects:
Sig Mallard Creek and David Taylor- 4292000325 (\$40,000)
Sig Mod Stonewall and Caldwell - 4292000326 (\$51,000)
- Section 3. That the existence of this project may extend beyond the end of the fiscal year. Therefore, this ordinance will remain in effect for the duration of the project and funds are to be carried forward to subsequent fiscal years until all funds are expended or the project is officially closed.

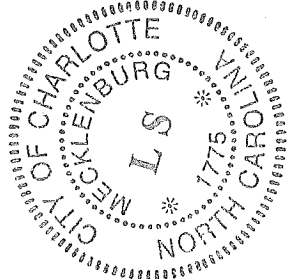


AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE DEMOLITION AND REMOVAL OF THE DWELLING AT 9336 PINWOOD AVENUE PURSUANT TO THE HOUSING CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE AND ARTICLE 19, PART 6, CHAPTER 160A OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF NORTH CAROLINA, SAID BUILDING BEING THE PROPERTY OF UNKNOWN TRUSTEE OF THE FAMILY TRUST CREATED BY THE WILL OF EMMITT PRESTON OSBORNE 8236 DOUGLAS DRIVE CHARLOTTE, NC 28217

WHEREAS, the dwelling located at 9336 Pinewood Avenue in the City of Charlotte has been found by the Code Enforcement Official of the City of Charlotte to be in violation of the Housing Code of the City of Charlotte and the owners thereof have been ordered to demolish and remove said dwelling; and

WHEREAS, said owner(s) have failed to comply in a timely fashion.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, that the Code Enforcement Official of the City of Charlotte is hereby ordered to cause the demolition and removal of the dwelling located at 9336 Pinewood Avenue in the City of Charlotte in accordance with the Housing Code of the City of Charlotte. 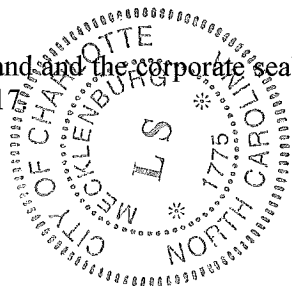
