

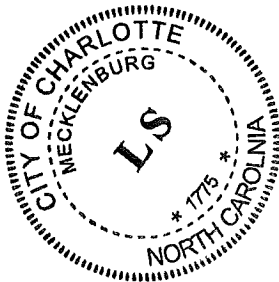

SC Hondros (\$6,500)


