



HIGHLIGHTS FOR 2019

- Fatal crashes decreased 12% from 2018
- Began construction of permanent protected bike lanes on The Plaza from Central Avenue to Parkwood Avenue
- Installed 5th/6th street cycle track with interim vertical posts for trial implementation
- Installed 4 Leading Pedestrian Interval Plus treatments at heavy right turn locations
- Reduced speed limits on 181 local streets to 25 mph where requested for traffic calming
- Conducted 50 enforcement events on the High Injury Network (HIN)

- Identified and prioritized 93 segments for street lighting improvements along HIN
- Installed 22 new traffic signals with full pedestrian accommodations
- Participated in 18 public events to share messaging about Vision Zero
- Shared Vision Zero safety messaging weekly via social media
- Published HIN crash data on the City's Open Data Portal
- Constructed 43 new or improved pedestrian crossings
- Piloted speed cushions & speed tables with Charlotte Fire for neighborhood traffic calming
