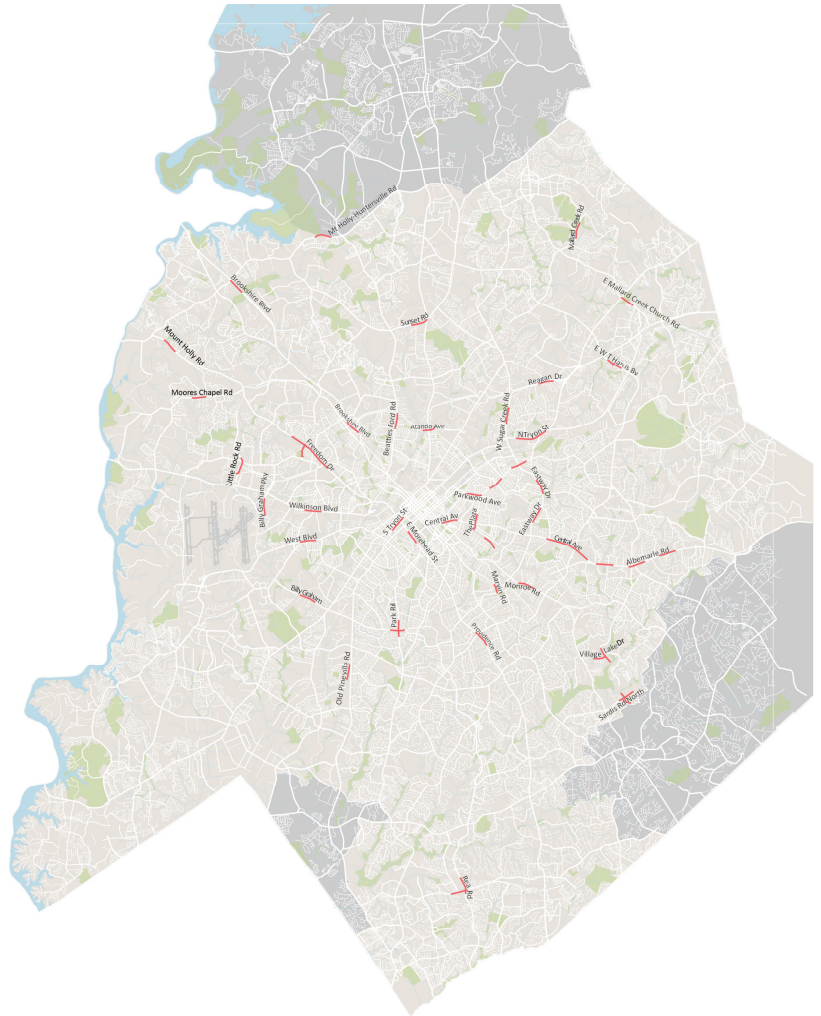

Report Out – CMPD Enforcement Focus Areas

- ▶ 10% of all streets in Charlotte make up the HIN
 - ▶ 66% arterial streets
 - ▶ 25% local streets
 - ▶ 9% collectors
- ▶ 50 streets have been identified as Priority Corridors





2019 Vision Zero Enforcement Operations to Date

- ▶ **50** Identified High Injury Networks (HINs) by CDOT
 - ▶ **25** Goal for Planned Operations in These Areas
 - ▶ **53** Actual Operations YTD
- ▶ **47** Speed Enforcement Operations
 - ▶ **1751** Speeding Citations
 - ▶ **2650** Total Charges
- ▶ **9** Seatbelt Operations
 - ▶ **156** Seatbelt Citations
 - ▶ **322** Total Charges
- ▶ **19** DWI Operations
 - ▶ **35** DWI Arrests
 - ▶ **1774** Total Charges
