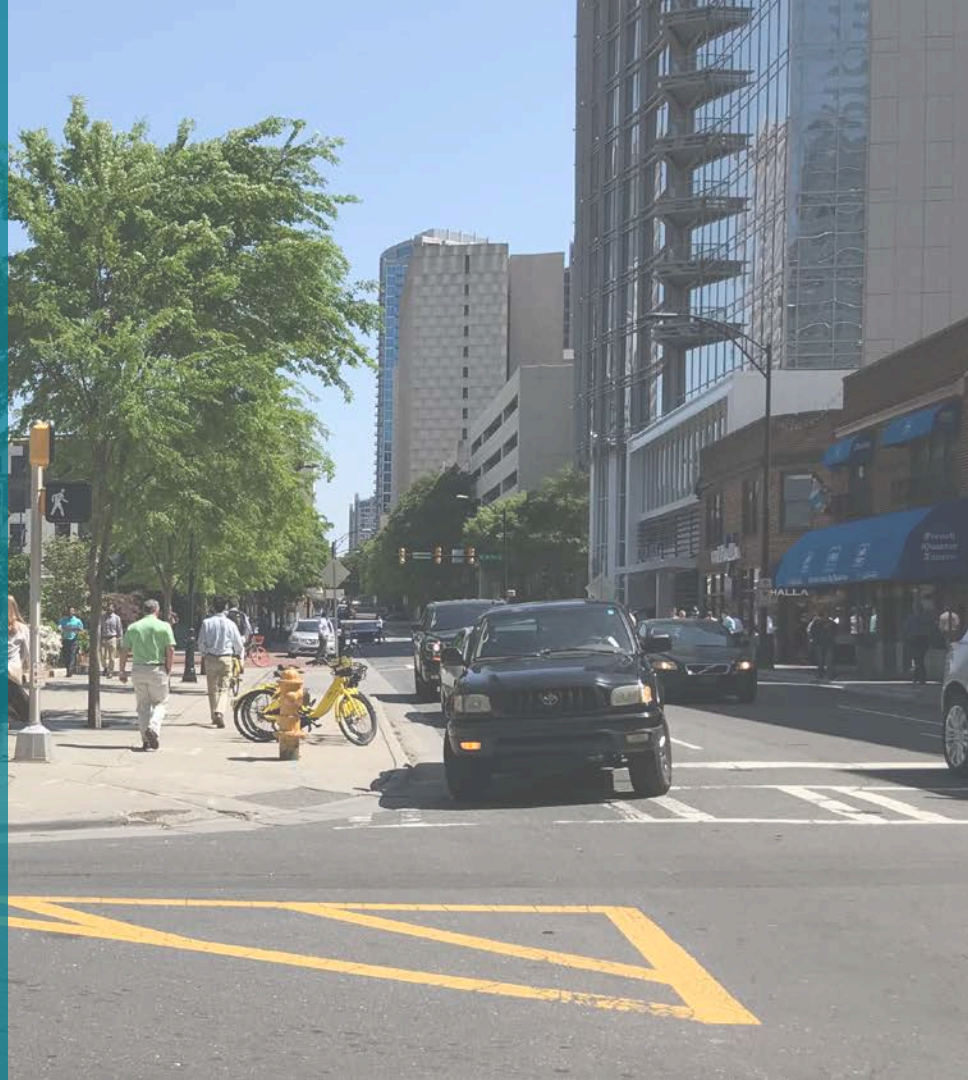

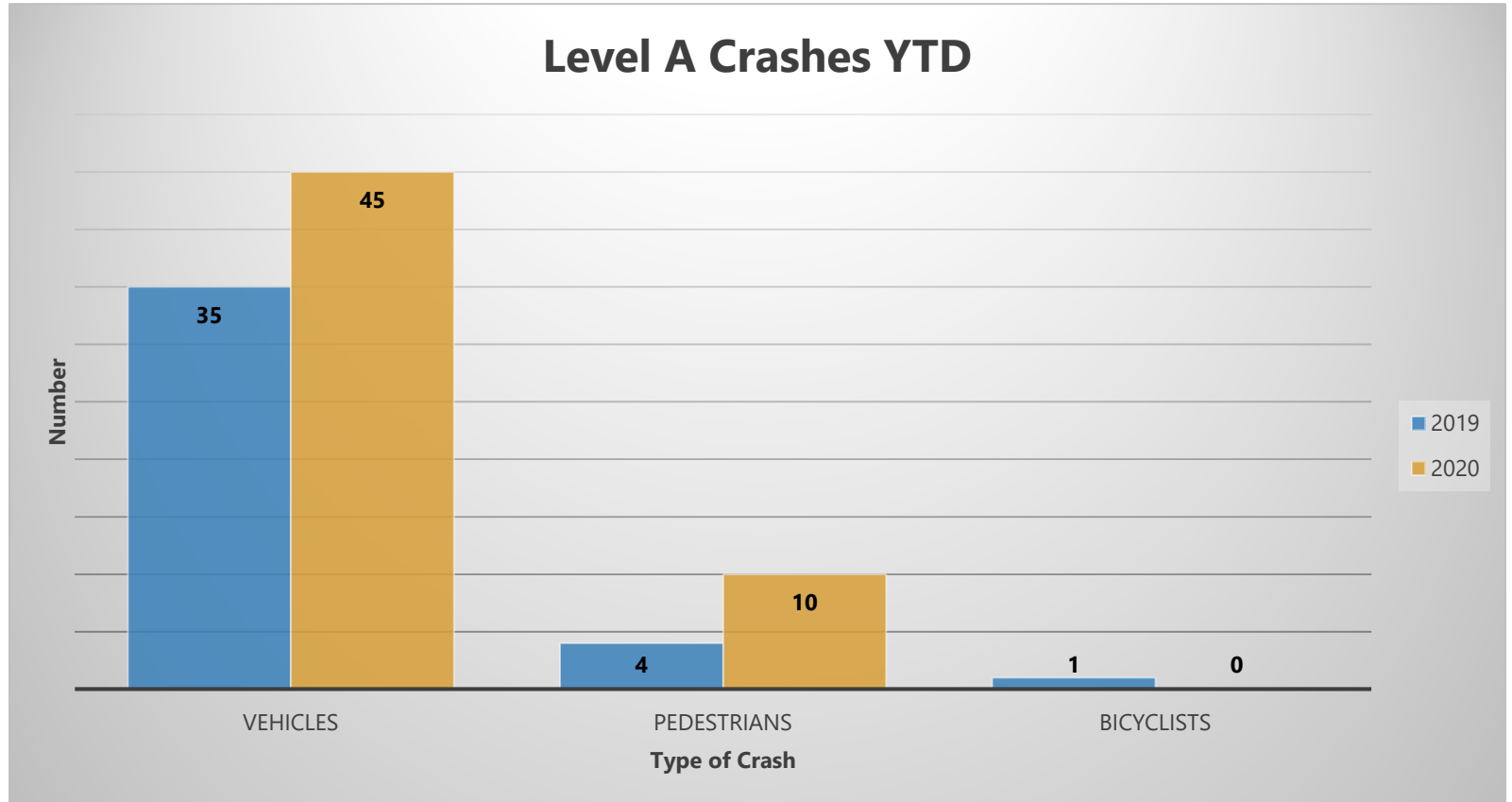

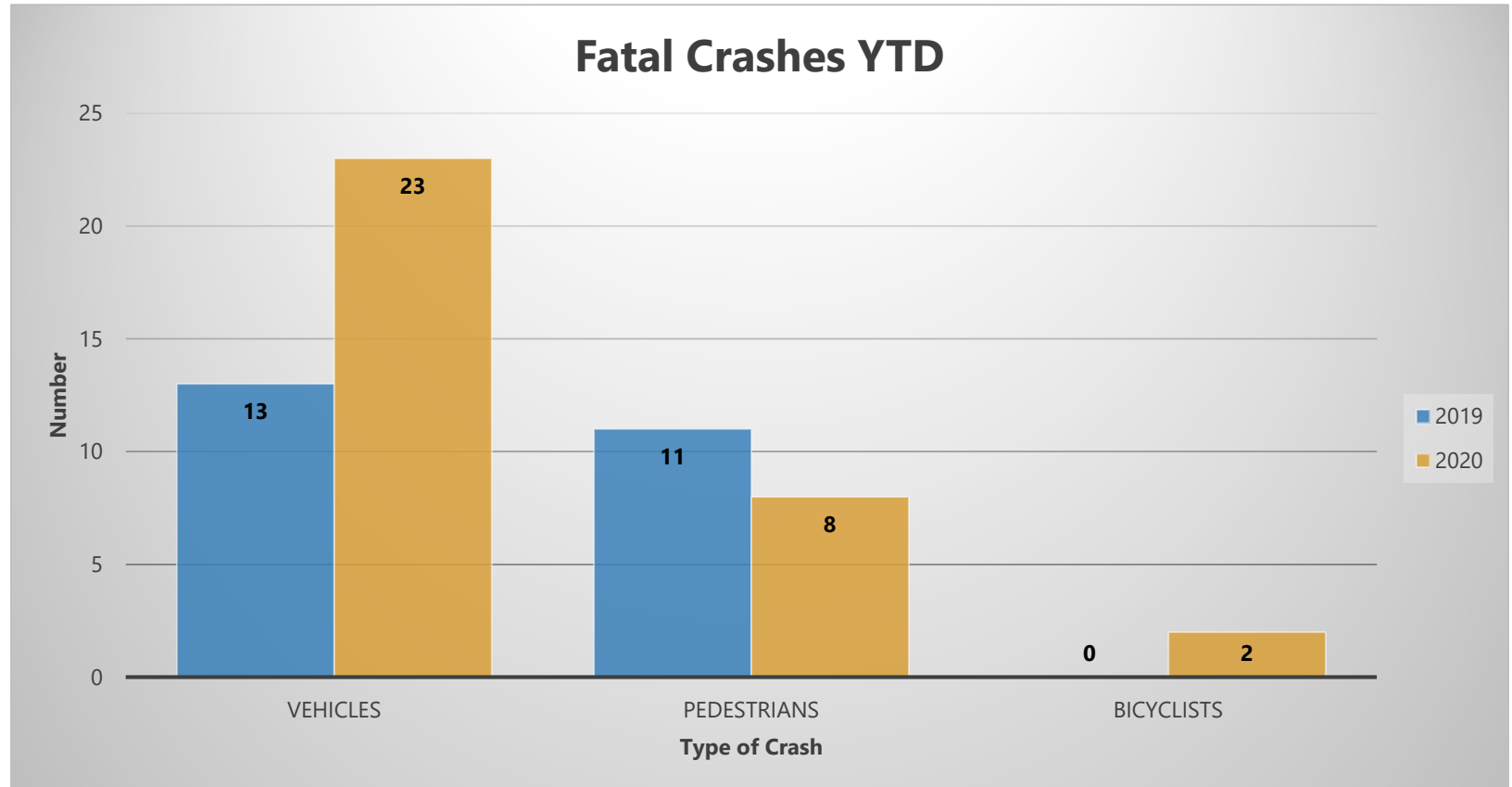

## Strategy Table Update – Highlights

- ▶ Began evaluation of the use of exclusive pedestrian phase in Uptown
- ▶ Reduce speed limits on streets to 25 mph in Uptown scheduled for this month
- ▶ Medically at Risk education video and form for CMPD is 100% complete & approved by CMPD
- ▶ Began serious injury crash investigations for bicyclists and pedestrians by CDOT Traffic Safety
- ▶ Participated in the 5-year update to the State Highway Safety Plan update
