Vision Zero Progress Update 2021-2024

- Developed PPT presentations and resources in Spanish.
- Installed 22 PHB's and 19 RRFBs.
- Installed 15 new school zone flashers and 80 LPIs.
- Constructed 40 miles of new sidewalks.
- Attended 100+ in-person engagement events.
- Trained over 60 field employees in CDOT on proper traffic control.

- Installed 69 speed cushions.
- Trained 240 individuals representing 63 construction companies who work in the city's right-of-way.
- Established 29 miles of dedicated bike lanes.
- Reduced speed limits on 275 streets.
- Installed/upgraded 4,600 streetlights along HIN
 - 2,600 New Lights
 - 2,000 LED's

High Injury Network (2019 - 2023)


KSI Score
