






Report Out – 2018 Fatal & Serious Injury Crashes




In 2018, people walking and bicycling were involved in less than <u>3% of all crashes</u> but accounted for <u>46% of all traffic deaths</u>



Report Out – 2018 Fatal & Serious Injury Crashes




Report Out – 2019 YTD Fatal & Serious Injury Crashes



Report Out – CMPD Enforcement Focus Areas

- 10% of all streets in Charlotte make up the HIN
 - 66% arterial streets
 - 25% local streets
 - 9% collectors
- 42 streets have been identified
 as Priority Corridors
