

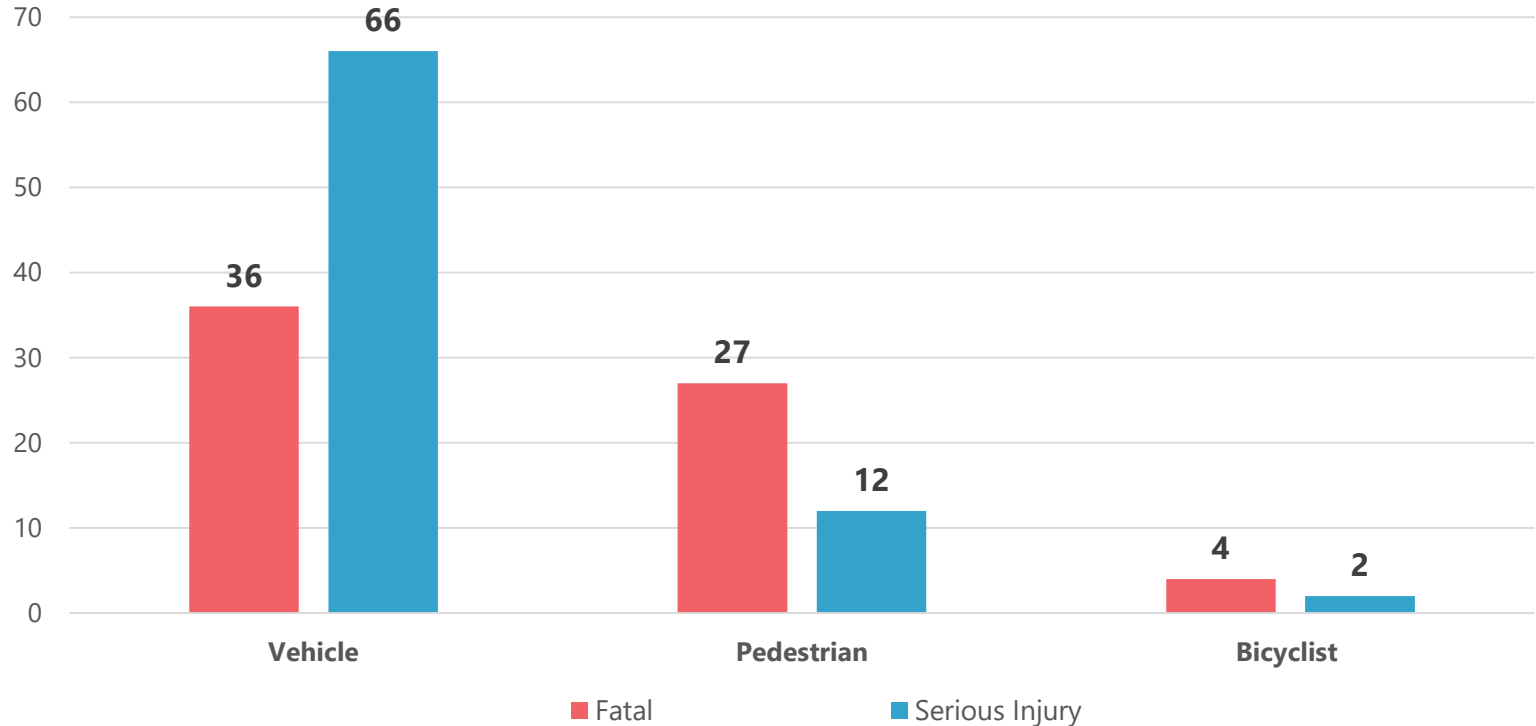

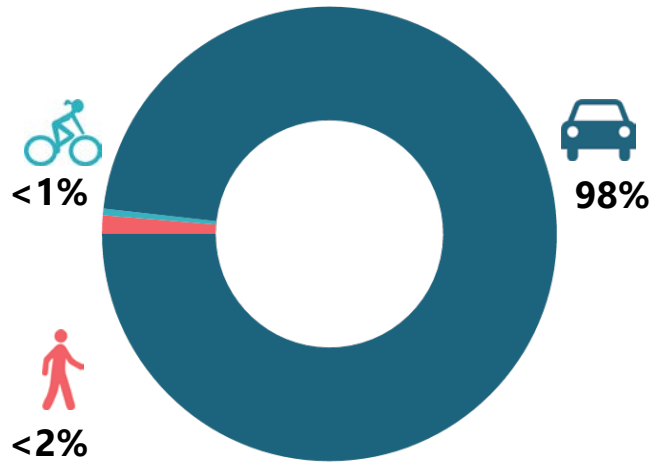

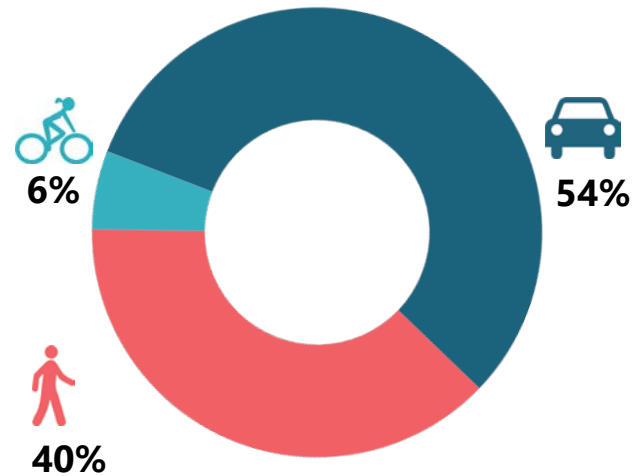
Report Out – 2018 Fatal & Serious Injury Crashes



In 2018, people walking and bicycling were involved in less than 3% of all crashes but accounted for 46% of all traffic deaths

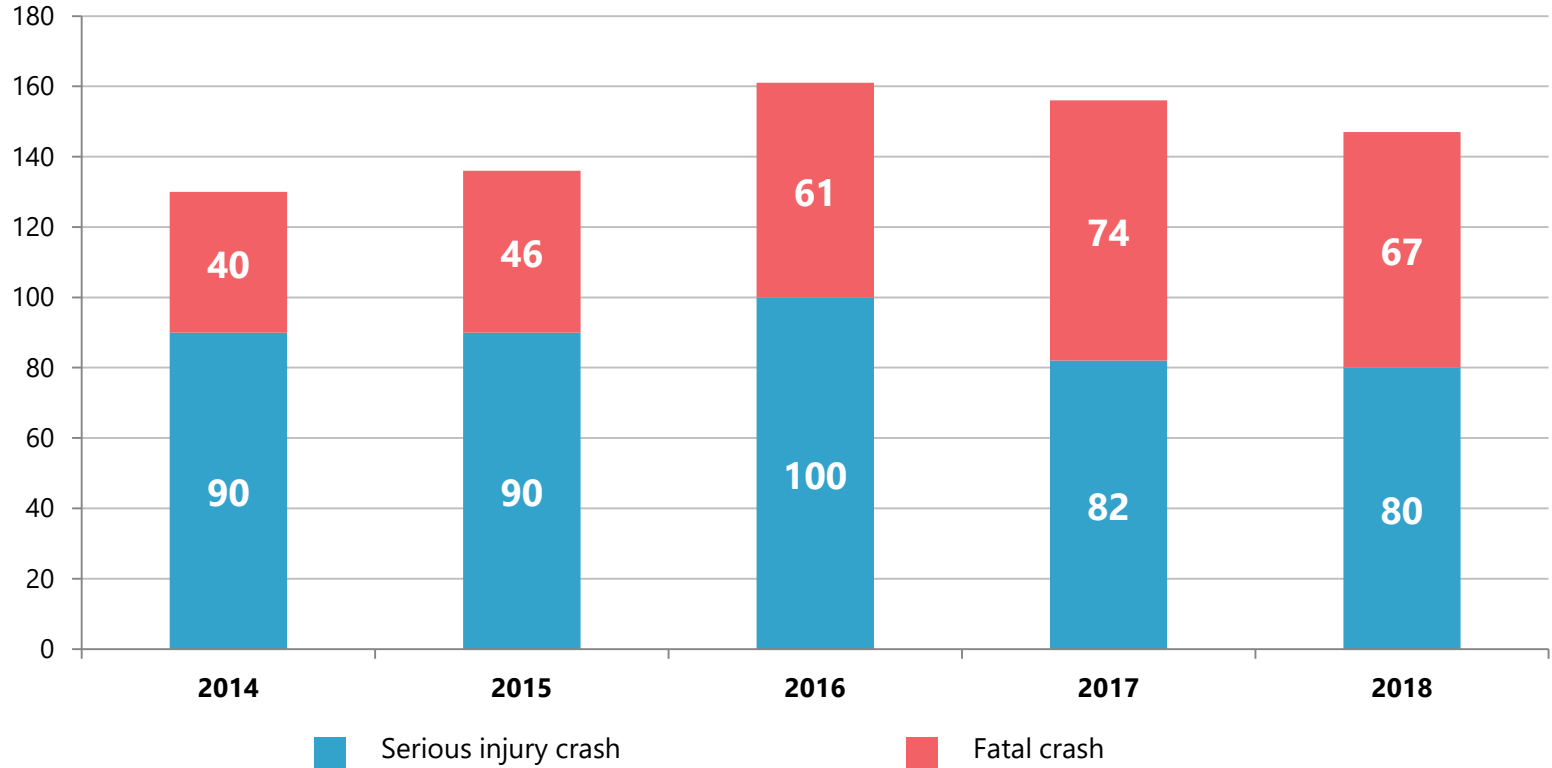


Crashes by Mode

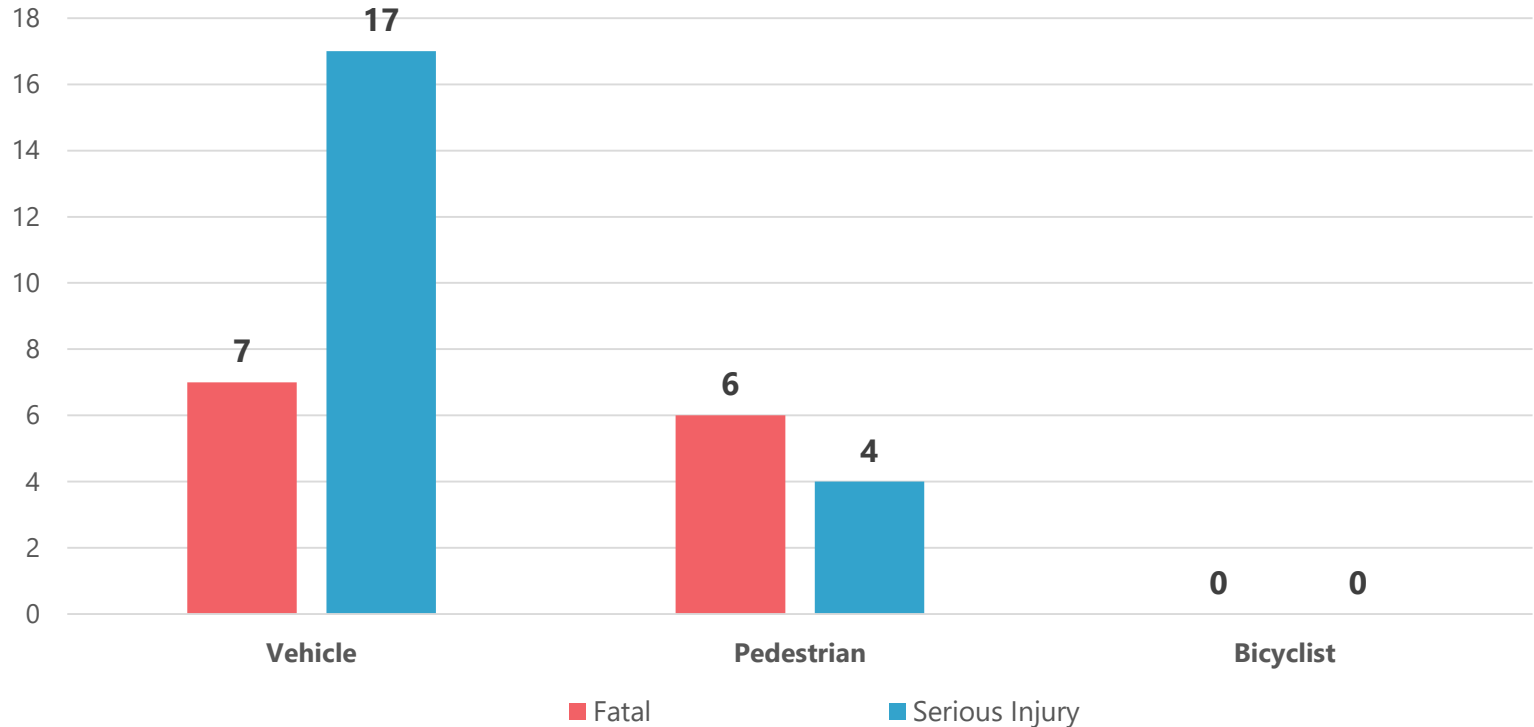


People Killed by Mode

Report Out – 2018 Fatal & Serious Injury Crashes

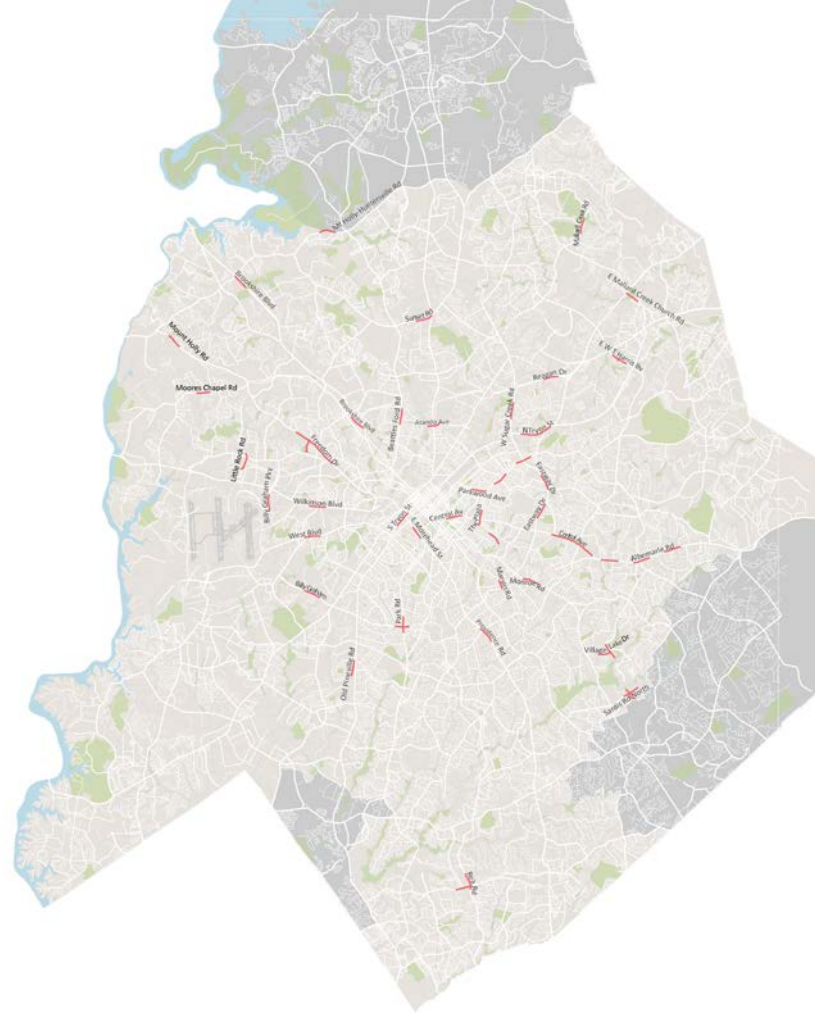


Report Out – 2019 YTD Fatal & Serious Injury Crashes



Report Out – CMPD Enforcement Focus Areas

- ▶ 10% of all streets in Charlotte make up the HIN
 - ▶ 66% arterial streets
 - ▶ 25% local streets
 - ▶ 9% collectors
- ▶ 42 streets have been identified as Priority Corridors
