REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL RFP AVIA 25-02 ON-CALL WINDOW WASHING SERVICES ADDENDUM # 1 FEBRUARY 3, 2025

This Addendum is hereby made a part of the contract documents and specifications of the abovereferenced project. All other requirements of the original plans and specifications shall remain in effect in their respective order. Acknowledge receipt of this addendum by inserting its number and date on Form #1 of your proposal.

General Note:

Proposals for the above will be received via the e-bidding portal until 2:00 pm EST on February 13, 2025.

Scope of Work Additional Information:

- Section 3: Exhibit A, Section 2, Services Scope of Work, # 2 of the RFP is hereby deleted and replaced with the following: *Furnish all equipment and supplies required to perform the work. This should include a manlift, boom lift to accommodate high cleaning work. CLT may provide the manlift around and inside the terminal.*
- Section 3: Exhibit A, Section 2, Services Scope of Work, # 6 of the RFP is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:
 Perform all cleaning between the hours of 10:00 PM and 4:30 AM or as gareed to on

Perform all cleaning between the hours of 10:00 PM and 4:30 AM or as agreed to on individual cases by the Facility Services Manager and the Company:

- a. The Airport will provide an elevator operator when needed during work inside the elevator shaft. This work must be scheduled.
- b. No puddling inside the elevator shaft to protect the control units.
- 3. The following is added to Section 3: Exhibit A, Section 2, Services Scope of Work, as # 17 of the RFP:

Bidders may hook a hose to the orange fire hydrants only. All other hydrants must have a backflow prevention valve. Bidders may borrow the backflow prevention valve from CLT. Bidders are responsible for replacement if damaged or lost.



Questions received are answered as follows:

1. Can you please provide the current contract pricing?

The maximum amount of the Contract shall not exceed three hundred and seventy-five thousand dollars (\$375,000).

2. On the diversity and inclusion program - is it required? And if so, what is the participation goal/percentage? On page 19 of the RFP Section D. Goal, the RFP states "xxx" percent.

Yes, this contract is subject to the requirements of the Charlotte Business INClusion (CBI) Program. The Bidder is required to identify a minimum of one (or more) CBI certified vendors to work with under the contract on the CBI Form 3 they submit with their proposal. A CBI Contract Goal will be negotiated with the awarded firm(s) prior to contract execution.

Note: CBI certified firms bidding as Prime may count their performance towards the contract goal.

3. During the site walk it was noted that the orange fire hydrants were available for water use. Referring to page 27 of the RFP section 3. ... Do we need to get a water permit if we are able to use the orange hydrants?

Yes, a water permit is required.

4. How many times do you want this done each year?

This is an on-call contract and services will be requested as needed.

5. When you say May 1st as the start date, how soon after this day do you need to start the project?

This is an on-call contract and services will be requested as needed.

6. What is the ideal timeline to complete the whole project?

The term of the Contract will be for three (3) years from the Effective Date with an option to renew for up to two (2) additional one-year terms.



7. Can you clarify where your boom lifts are provided in light of the spec reference on the response form?

One lift will be provided to Bidders for the cleaning of the Main Terminal windows; both inside and outside. Bidders must complete CLT training before use.

8. Inside the Concourse and Terminal where we have to clean above 10ft. Can we rope off the boom lift during the day when not using this or do we have to move it outside?

No.

9. Can we operate multiple boom lifts at once inside or outside?

This will be determined on a location-by-location basis. CLT will only provide one lift in the areas referenced in Question 7.

10. Since we are allowed to clean between 10 PM - 4:30 AM each day. Are we able to set up and tear down one hour before start and one hour after finishing each day? Is this flexible for the areas around the parking decks?

We have flexibility in all areas excluding the Main Terminal.

11. Are you able to provide a detailed map of the facilities that match the bid response form? We would like to be 100% on the same page with the Response forms abbreviation.

A detailed map can be provided upon award.

12. When you award the project, will it be partitioned out or given in full? I understand that the document says this is a potential. This will be helpful to know so we can reduce the cost of boom lifts.

Propose as if given in full. Any changes will be negotiated with the company(s).

13. Are the chairs easily movable in the new concourse for boom lifts etc.?

Yes, the chairs are easily movable.



14. Is there any kind of schedule you try to abide to? What has been the frequency of windows getting cleaned in the last 3 years?

This is an on-call contract and services will be requested as needed. Frequency has been limited but not expected in the future.

15. What is the amount of lead time we receive when you have a request?

Lead time may vary. Historically, we have known in advance when work will be requested.

16. What were the costs in the last three years to perform the window washing and could you share a budget for this year?

The maximum amount of the Contract shall not exceed three hundred and seventy-five thousand dollars (\$375,000). We do not have a finalized budget.

17. We estimate a 60ft boom lift will give us access to the exterior areas we need. Could you clarify if there are areas where any bigger lift is needed?

The 60' should be sufficient in all areas.

18. What is the difference between the Old Terminal and TLE?

The Old Terminal is located on Yorkmont Road on the south side of the campus. The Terminal Lobby Expansion, TLE, is the main entrance to the terminal.

19. Is the terminal overhang included? If so, what is that part of TLE?

Terminal Overhang is not included.

Submission Requirements:


- Companies must submit ONE (1) original and complete proposal in searchable Adobe Acrobat .pdf format, signed in ink, or digitally signed.
