Summary of Presentation/Discussion

The Petitioner's agent, Dennis Terry, welcomed the attendees and introduced the Victory Lane Karting Petitioner team. Mr. Terry indicated that the Petitioner proposed to rezone an approximately 7.96 Acre site located at 3629 Statesville Avenue from ML-1 and N2-B to IMU (EX). Mr. Terry explained the rezoning process in general and stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the rezoning request and the conditional site plan and respond to questions and concerns from nearby residents and property owners.

Mr. Terry provided background information about the Petitioner's experience and the typical operation of its facilities. He then presented the site plan and pointed out various commitments made by the Petitioner. Mr. Priest then explained and discussed the proposed architectural design of the proposed facility.

Mr. Cooper, and adjacent property owner, was very interested and excited about the project,
