



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Citizen Notification

City Council Public Hearing

- Required by State Law to allow an opportunity for:
 - **City Council and Zoning Committee**
 - Petitioner/agent to present the petition • Community to provide comments to
- Must sign up to speak with City Clerk (704 - 336 - 2248)
- Speaking time is limited to 3 minutes total if no opposition and 10 minutes per side if opposition







Zoning Committee

- Zoning Committee attends Council Public Hearing
- Zoning Committee review open to public, but no public comment received during meeting



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City Council Decision

- Council makes final decisions on rezoning requests typically at the next Zoning meeting
 - In addition to speaking at Public Hearing, Citizens may contact mail and email
