
DAVIDSON SOUTH STREET

WHERE IS THE PROJECT ROUTE?

 The project route begins on South St. near Davidson Elementary School and will end near the Hillside Dr./Lorimer Rd. intersection.

HOW LONG WILL CONSTRUCTION TAKE?

 Construction began in Summer 2022 and is expected to be complete by Fall 2023.

WHAT SHOULD THE PUBLIC EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION?

- Staging of materials and equipment, deep excavations, and pipe installation
- Construction traffic, traffic signage, personnel in the area, activity in the project area, etc.
- Short momentary disruptions to service may occur, however, we will do our best to notify residents, and businesses in the impacted area in advance
