# Dixie River Road Water Project Update

Charlotte Water (CLTWater) will extend drinking water pipes along Dixie River Road from the 5900 block of Dixie River Road to Sadler Road.

## What to Expect:

Clearing of the easement will begin late March and water pipe construction is scheduled to start in June 2023.

Construction can be loud, dirty and inconvenient. Crews will reduce disruptions where possible. Crews will be using heavy equipment and storing materials on-site. Construction will take place in and beside the roadway within the right-of-way.

## Property Access (Driveway)

Driveway access may be limited at times. If you need assistance, please talk to the contractor or call the project inspector.

## Pipe delivery and storage

Pipe is delivered and stored within the construction easements.

## Construction traffic

Dump trucks will travel along the alignment, within the easements and roadway.

The easement and temporary construction easement will be cleared of trees (with some exceptions) and restored to grass after pipe installation. CLTWater will preserve trees if possible.
