Contractors for Charlotte Water are working on the Little Hope Creek Wastewater Improvement Project, which will enhance wastewater services for customers in the Little Hope Creek basin, primarily in the Sedgefield and Madison Park neighborhoods.

Detours on Hartford Avenue

Starting April 24, crews will be working along Hartford Avenue to replace the wastewater pipeline. Closures on Hartford Avenue will be phased (see maps below).


Phase 1 map


Hartford Avenue Closure

Phase 3a: Hartford Avenue is expected to be closed from Hollis Road to the school entrance from May 8 – May 12. Please detour through Hollis Road to Anson Street to Hartford Avenue.


Phase 3b: Hartford Avenue is expected to be closed from the school entrance to Auburn Avenue from May 15 – May 22. Please detour Hartford Avenue to Anson Street to Hollis Road to Hartford Avenue.

Please note that crews plan to work over the weekend of May 13-14 to lay pipe past the school entrance.
