



**Little Hope Creek: Phase 3 Virtual Public Meeting  
October 23, 2023**

**QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**

*Answered by Will Rice, Charlotte Water, and Austin Bailey, Park Construction*

Below is a summary of the Q&A session.

**Q1: Are we still on target for Mockingbird field (staging area) to be fully demobilized and restored by summer 2024?**

A: Yes. We are on target, but progress depends on the rock in the basin along the alignment.

**Q2: Will roads be repaved at Mockingbird field (staging area) and Terence at project completion?**

A: Yes, we will repave the roads; there's already been some repair work, and further extensive permanent repair work will be done.

**Q3: What will be the hours of operation during construction?**

A: Generally, the hours will be 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. during the week, with holiday shutdowns observed.

**Q4: Will large trucks still be coming in along Woodlawn, Barkley and Terence during construction?**

A: Yes, large trucks will be involved in deliveries and moving materials throughout the duration of Phase 3 construction.

**Q5: Will specialized trees, such as pecans, black walnut, and oaks, be saved or donated for other use?**

A: No, clearing we do on this project involves mulching with the mulch being used for the project. Trees are mulched for environmental purposes – erosion control along the creek banks – which protects the water quality of the creek.

**Q6: Do you have a map of the trees you plan to remove along section 3a?**

A: No specific tree-by-tree map, but project plans show areas to be cleared within easements.

**Q7: How can we view which side of the creek the right-of-way will be?**

A: It's challenging to pinpoint specific locations, but project plans can provide some visuals as we progress.

**Q8: Will the rock and soil be moved away from the neighborhood instead of being stored on Mockingbird staging area?**

A: Yes, we will be fully demobilized from the Mockingbird site eventually.

**Q9: When will clearing begin for section 3a?**

A: Clearing is expected to start in early to mid-November.

**Q10: Are you crossing the creek again?**

A: Yes, the alignment crosses the creek multiple times based on the best design for the project.
