Monroe Road Streetscape - Community Member Questionnaire

We are seeking your feedback on potential improvements for Phase I of the Monroe Road Streetscape Project. Please help us by completing this form and returning it to a staff member tonight.

Why is there a Phase I and Phase II to this project? The Monroe Road Streetscape Project will be constructed in two phases based on the allocation of funding for the project. The City of Charlotte has approximately \$2 million available for Phase I improvements, which will focus on the section of the project corridor from Wendover Road to Briar Creek Road where existing constraints (existing development, utilities, etc.) limit the ability to make large-scale modifications without substantial impacts. Phase I improvements could be constructed in 2019.

Phase II of the project will focus of the section of the project corridor from Wendover Road to Sharon Amity Road as additional funding becomes available following approval of the 2018 and 2020 community investment bonds. Construction of Phase II improvements is anticipated to begin in 2021.
