CFD Interpretation: Use of Portable Electric Space Heaters

Date: June 9, 2014

Code Reference: North Carolina Fire Code, Section 605

Subject: Are electric space heaters allowed in businesses?

Interpretation:

Yes. Electric space heaters are allowed in all occupancies EXCEPT Institutional occupancies such as hospitals and nursing homes. The use of the heaters must comply with ALL of the following:

- 1. Heaters must be a UL listed and labeled device.
- 2. The use of an extension cord is prohibited; heater must plug directly into a wall outlet.
- 3. A minimum clearance of 3-feet shall be maintained from the heater to any combustible material.
