Beginning January 1, 2023, Charlotte Fire Department will require shop drawings for projects in the Charlotte city limits be submitted through this Electronic Plan Management (EPM) portal. The first web link is to help you with setting up an account and submitting through EPM. The second web link is how to submit an RTAP. Most shop drawings are to be submitted as an RTAP. The only time it will be a standalone project is when there is no project in which to attach the shop drawing.

Any resubmittal of plans that were originally submitted through the email portal shall be submitted back through the email portal. cfdplansubmittal@ci.charlotte.nc.us

By using the six-digit project number assigned by the county at time of the original permit application by the architect, the system should recognize the project as a city fire or county fire assignment. Contact either:
