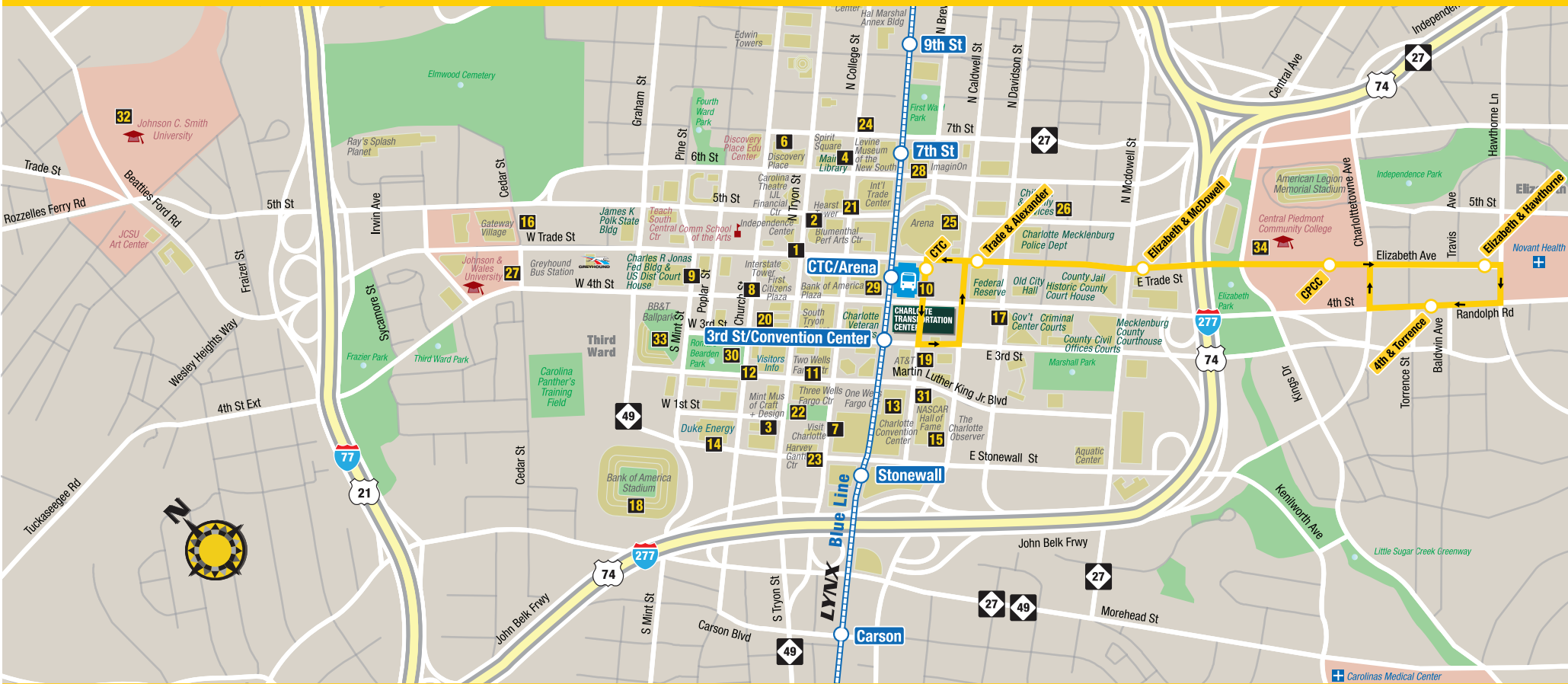

Construction of the CityLYNX Gold Line Streetcar Project - Phase 2 continues. In order to safely and efficiently raise the existing stop platforms for level boarding with the new, modern streetcars and upgrade power on the current Gold Line, service will discontinue on **Monday, June 3, 2019**, until Phase 2 opens.

Service to and from all existing Gold Line destinations will be accessible via the CityLYNX Connector Bus Service. For stop locations, familiarize yourself with the map and look for bus stops along the current Gold Line route that say "CityLYNX Connector". Be at your stop a few minutes early. Look at the headway sign above the windshield for the name "CityLYNX Connector" and be sure to stand where the bus operator can see you.

When boarding allow other passengers to exit first. Then step on and enjoy the ride. About one block from your stop, gather your belongings and prepare to exit through the rear doors. The CityLYNX Connector serves the Charlotte Transportation Center so you can easily connect to the LYNX Blue Line or to any number of CATS local and express bus routes. The CityLYNX Connector is a **FREE** service.
