In order to maintain consistency with submittals and plan reviews among all utility stake holders, the following plan submittal requirements shall minimize review times and expedite your reviews/approvals:

- o Drawings shall be in color to scale submitted in 11 x 17 PDF format
- Cover page to include:
 - 1. Utility Company Name & Contact Information
 - 2. Utility Project Name and Number
 - 3. Vicinity Map
 - 4. Legend
 - 5. North Arrow
- CDOT General Construction Notes
- Installation Method Details:
 - 1. Aerial
 - 2. Directional Boring
 - 3. Trenching
 - 4. Pneumatic Hammering (Missile)
 - 5. Plowing
 - 6. Jack & Boring
 - 7. Hand hole/Vault Detail
 - 8. CDOT Typical Details (number of conduit/cable, conduit & hand holes etc.)
- Plan View to show:
 - 1. ROW Lines
 - 2. Street Names
 - 3. Property Lines & Addresses
 - 4. Edge Of Pavement (EOP) and Curb & Gutter (C&G)
 - 5. Planting Strip
 - 6. Sidewalks (Concrete, Brick Pavers, and Decorative Pavers)
