
Is Your Property In The Floodplain?

Find out if your property is located in the regulated floodplain

Go online to:

- StormWater.CharMeck.org
- Click on the 3D Floodzone Map tab
- Type in address or parcel ID number

A map will appear outlining the property. If the property is in a blue area on the map, it is in a regulated floodplain, sometimes called a flood zone.

Realtors may want to use Mecklenburg County's online Polaris 3G map.

- Enter address or parcel identific vation number in the search box at the upper left.
- Click Go to results, the parcel map should appear.
- From the list on the left, select Community and FEMA Floodplains.

By clicking Floodplain, Zoning and Watershed Information, additional floodplain information is displayed on the left including a link to the 3D Floodzone Interactive Mapping where you can determine the building's elevation, risk of annual flooding and more.
