Why The Project Was Chosen

- Reported concerns from property owners to 311 within watershed included:
 - Inadequate/Undersized Drainage Infrastructure
 - Deteriorating Infrastructure (old culverts, pipes, inlets)
 - Sink Holes
 - Channel Erosion
- Larger watershed-wide issues that cannot be managed by individual repairs or without potentially impacting downstream properties












- Stormwater Storage




























































Project Phases













- The planning phase has been completed
- Design and easement acquisition are the current phases





Design

- All permits will be obtained
 - Section 401/404
 - Erosion ad Sedimentation Control
 - Charlotte Water
 - CDOT
- All easements will be acquired
- Construction documents will be completed
 - Plans
 - Specifications
 - Construction Cost Estimate







Easement Acquisition

- An easement is a right to use land owned by another party for a specific purpose
- Easements provide Storm Water Services with permission from property owners to come onto their property and repair drainage problems and perform on-going maintenance
- Easements do not reduce the size of your property, but it does create some limitations on the use of the area







Easement Types

Storm Drainage Easement (SDE)

Grants permanent access to a specific portion of the property for the purpose of repairing and maintaining a storm drainage system including pipes and creeks.

Temporary Construction Easement (TCE)

Are not permanent easements. They give us the right to access your property to construct this project only.

Other types of easements include Public Utility Easement (PUE) and Sanitary Sewer Easement (SSE).


