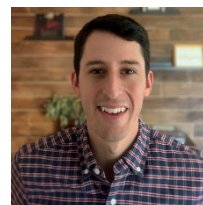
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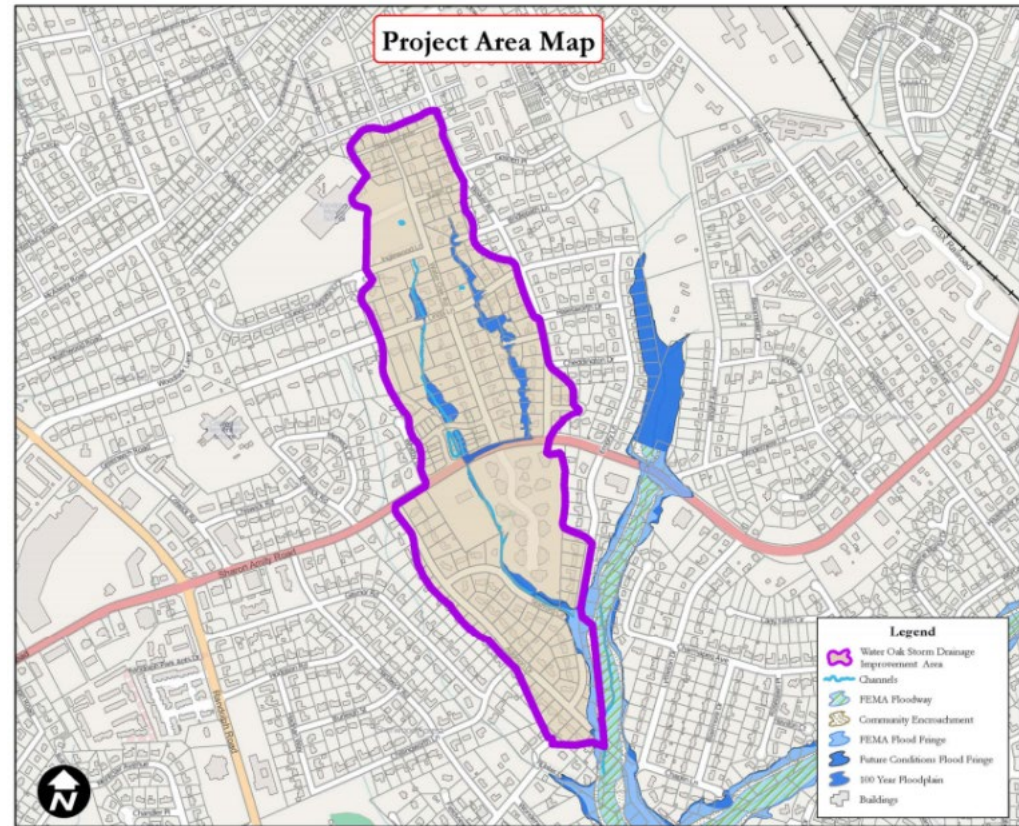

# Project Highlights

- Reduce street and structure flooding throughout the neighborhood
- Replace aging infrastructure and provide adequate drainage system capacity
- Construction contractor: Sealand Contractors Corp.
- Project start: Spring 2023
- Anticipated completion: Summer 2025
- Estimated cost: \$14,100,000



# Construction

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## What should you expect to see?

- Heavy duty construction vehicles like:
  - Dump trucks
  - Concrete trucks
  - Excavators
- Dirty and muddy conditions
- Pipe, dirt, gravel and supplies kept on site within City right-of-way and/or storm drainage easements





# Construction

## Will traffic be impacted?

- Some intersections will be closed to install stormwater pipe, sanitary sewer lines and water lines
- Streets with active construction will generally be closed to through traffic
- Some streets will require full road closures
- Local traffic will have access
- Signs will assist motorists



# Construction

## Will you lose driveway access to your property?

- Driveway access will be impacted during construction
- Advance notification will be provided
- Contractor will coordinate alternative access



# Construction

## Will on street parking be impacted?

- On street parking may be reduced to one side of the street or eliminated to provide safe access for construction vehicles





# Construction

## Will your water or sewer services be disrupted?

- When a service interruption becomes necessary, affected customers will be notified 72 hours in advance
- Any unplanned service outages are considered urgent
