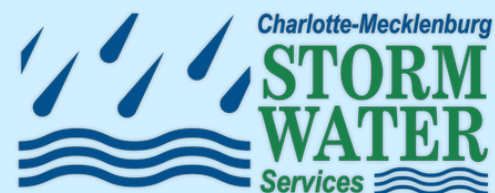

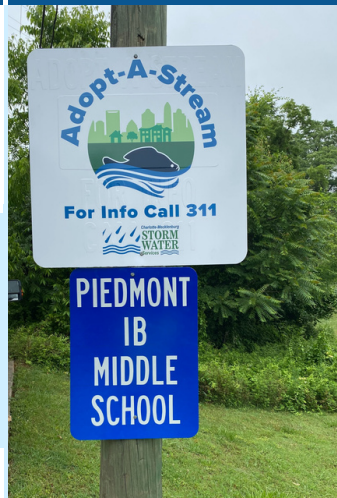

Our Volunteer Programs

Adopt-A-Stream

Gather a school, church or neighborhood group together and commit to cleaning a stream near you! In exchange, you get an awesome street sign. We provide you with all supplies needed.



Streamside Snapshot

If you enjoy walking along greenway trails, then this program is for you! Just look for our signs and take a picture of the creek to send in and let us know if there are any pollution concerns.



Volunteer Monitoring

Take a closer look at a stream or cove near you by participating in Volunteer Monitoring. You can take visual or chemical assessments that get reported back to our staff.



Adopt-A-Drain

Adopt the drain in front of your house or office to ensure it is clear for rain to easily enter it. You will receive a monthly reminder, mostly before storms roll into the area.



Storm Drain Marking

You can have a kit mailed directly to your house or pickup supplies from our office to help remind others that the storm drains lead to our waterways.



Tree Maintenance

Come out and help us prune, weed and straighten trees planted in the floodplain to keep those trees healthy and strong.
