Community Area Planning


Purpose: Refine and provide <u>community-level</u> <u>guidance</u> for growth + development (including places, mobility, open space, capital facilities, community facilities & amenities)

Approach:

- Citywide = Equitable
- Larger geographies = Efficient

Benefits:

- Facilitate conversations and collaboration among neighborhoods to build upon similarities
- Reimagine major barriers that typically serve as neighborhood boundaries
- Efficiently identify citywide policy updates



How: Identify areas that will experience significant growth in the future and have infrastructure gaps today.

Plan For Action



Workshop: Determine Areas with Infrastructure Gaps

Your Impact:

- Further advances goals of the comprehensive plan
- Supports the conversations regarding infrastructure projects that is set to begin in 2024
- Reinforces community needs where growth is envisioned to occur







Plan For Action



Deliverable: Infrastructure recommendations that can be replicated throughout the City in areas with similar growth and infrastructure needs/gaps.

Inputs:

- Projected Household + Jobs Growth
- Equitable Growth Framework gaps
- Entitlements Data
- Infrastructure Data













Format:


- Work session format between 1 and 3 hours
- CEDC gathers around large format maps
- Maps represent conditions in specific area but that are common throughout the City
- Areas focus on Activity Center and 10 Min NB
- Staff provides guidance on the map conditions
- CEDC discusses what the needs are and begins to list infrastructure projects that are needed to complete the vision for that area
